Note : 1. A multi-stage system for the Level 3 Senior Civil Service Examination and Junior Examination was practiced between 1998 and 2005, during which period the number of examination registrants was taken from first-stage candidates.

2.The personnel systems of the former Directorate General of Highways and the Taiwan Area National Freeway Bureau were restructured into a dual-track rank-and-grade system on January 15 and February 12, 2018 respectively. Additionally, following the re-organization of the former Taiwan Railways Administration under the MOTC into the state-owned Taiwan Railway Corporation Limited on January 1, 2024, its recruitment is now handled independently or through other selection channels. As a result, the MOTC and its affiliated agencies no longer require recruitment through the highway and railway personnel examinations.

3.In accordance with the amended Article 32 of the Act for the Development of Tourism, promulgated on May 18, 2022, the certification process for tour guides and tour managers has been revised to require evaluation by the central competent authority or a designated agency. Since 2024, this evaluation has been conducted by the Ministry of Transportation and Communications (MOTC), and the MOEX no longer administers these examinations.
